CHIANG MAI PACKAGE

Chiang Mai, "Rose of the North", is among the most delightful and charming cities of Thailand. It has a number of other assets, including the folk art for which the North of Thailand has long been famous.



Day 1: Transfer to Bangkok Airport, depart for Chiang Mai. Arrive at Chiang Mai Airport, meet and transfer to the hotel.

13.30: Visit the sacred mountaintop temple of Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep and a picturesque Meohilltribe village.

17.30: Return to hotel.

Overnight

Day 2: American Breakfast.

08.30: Visit a jungle area north of the city to see elephants at work. The program includes a demonstration of how trained elephants are used to help in lumber work.



Stops are made at Queen Sirikit Botanic Garden, and at an orchid nursery.

Return to hotel.

Afternoon: At leisure.

Evening: Khantoke Dinner, a typical northern Thai meal with local variety shows.

Transfer to the airport for flight to Bangkok.

CHIANG RAI PACKAGE

Located 100 kilometers northeast of Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai is the gateway to the Golden Triangle. Most visitors to the town are interested in hilltribe trekking or taking a boat trip on the Kok River. A part of the Lanna Kingdom, there are several historic temple to visit.

Day1

Transfer to Bangkok Airport, depart for Chiang Rai.
Arrive Chiang Rai Airport, meet and transfer to the hotel.

13.30: Visit Chiang Rai City by comfortable, leisurely tricycle "samlor". Then transfer to microbus to visit famous temples, such as Wat Phra Keo where the much venerated Emerald Buddha image was once enshrined. Drive up a hill for a glimpse of the city and visit Wat Phra That Loy Phra Baht and Wat Doi Thong. Visit the statue of King Mengrai who built Chiang Rai City and Hilltribe Museum and Education Centre.



17.30: Return to hotel.
Overnight

Day 2: American Breakfast.

Full day to Akha and Yao Hilltribek, Mae Sai Border Town, Golden Triangle and Chiang Sean



08.30: Drive north from Chiang Rai to Mae Chan to visit Yeo and Akkhahilltribe villages where highly skillful and beautiful artifacts can be purchased. Then drive to Chiang Saen and visit Wat Chedi Luang, the first temple founded there. Next, take the road alongside the Mekong River for 12 kms to the Golden Triangle where the borders of three countries meet - Thailand, Myanmar (Burma) and Laos. After lunch at the Golden Triangle, proceed to Mae Sai at the northernmost tip of Thailand bordering Myanmar, through which passes an ancient trade route leading to Myanmar and Yunnan in China. Here many local and Burmese handicrafts are on display. Lunch is provided.

17.30: Return to hotel.
Overnight.

Day 3: American Breakfast.



AM: Visit White Temple or **Wat Ronghun** is a contemporary unconventional Buddhist and Hindu temple. It was designed by Chalemchai Kosipipat. Return to hotel and check -out.

Transfer to the airport for flight to Bangkok.
 Arrive Suvarnabhumi Airport, connect flight onward or transfer to hotel in Bangkok.



RIVER KWAI VILLAGE PACKAGE (Hellfire Pass, Bamboo Rafting & Elephant Riding)



Day 1

06.30 hrs.: Pick up from hotel in Bangkok.

07.30 hrs.: Depart Bangkok for Kanchanaburi

10.00 hrs.: Arrive Kanchanaburi, visit:

- Thailand-Burma Railway Centre : An open-air museum constructed in the form of actual prisoners of war (POW) camp. There are collections of the "Death Railway"
- Kanchanaburi War Cemetery : The cemetery contains the remains of over 6,000 prisoners of war, who lost their lives during the construction of the "Death Railway". Continue to visit the world famous Bridge on the River Kwai. As depicted in the movie and a part of the "Death Railway", the historical black iron bridge was the target of Allied bombing during 1945.

12.00 hrs. : Take a train ride along part of the "Death Railway" to Nam Tok station, the last existing train station of the Thailand-Burma railway in Thailand, passing the dangerous looking wooden viaduct built along the mountain.

13.00 hrs.: Arrive Nam-Tok station. Transfer to River Kwai Village Hotel

13.30 hrs.: Check-in at the hotel upon arrival. Thai lunch at jungle View Restaurant.

15.00 hrs. : Kaeng Lava Cave : Take a long-tailed speed boat upstream along the Kwai Noi River. Climb up to the Kaeng Lava Cave to explore unimaginary shapes of stone formations of the most beautiful cave in Thailand.

16.30 hrs. : Transfer back to the hotel by boat.

19.00 hrs. : Dinner. Accommodation.

Day 2

08.00 hrs. : American breakfast

08.30 hrs. : Hellfire Pass & the Elephant Tour: Depart the hotel to visit Hellfire Pass Memorials and a cutting mountain for a railway track which was done by hands of the Allied prisoners.

10.30 hrs. : Continue to the Elephant Camp, by bamboo rafting along a rushing stream of Kwai Noi River. Arrive the Elephant Camp for an exciting elephant back-riding through a jungle. Picnic lunch will be provided.

13.45 hrs. : Depart the Elephant Camp for hotel.

19.00 hrs. : European dinner. Accommodation.

12.30 hrs. : Thai lunch

14.30 hrs. : Depart the hotel for Bangkok

PHUKET PACKAGE

Phuket, Pearl of the south, is Thailand's largest island located in the tropical waters of the Andaman and the richest province in natural resources in the kingdom. Phuket is blessed with magnificent caves and bays, palm-fringed white sandy beaches, sparkling island-dotted seas, lovely waterfalls and parks.

Day1

: Transfer to Bangkok Airport, depart on flight to Phuket.

: Arrive at Phuket Airport, meet and transfer to the hotel.

PM : Phuket sightseeing tour.

Visit Khao Rang, a small hill near Phuket town, to see a beautiful panoramic view of the town and nearly the whole island. Then drive past the old section of Phuket town where the buildings still reflect early Chinese and Portuguese influence. Visit Wat Chalong, Phuket's most holy and renowned monastery; Phuket Shell Museum where you will see the large



Andaman Golden Pearl and a magnificent, rare collection of shells and fossils from



around the globe; Rawai Beach, Phuket's oldest beach resort; and on the west side of the beach, the place where the "sea people" live.

Then proceed to Phromthep Cape, a very special place at the southernmost tip of the island where you can see a panorama of stunning beauty.

Then visit Hat Noppharat Thara, one of Krabi's most beautiful beaches, and a shell cemetery.

AM: Excursion by speed boat to visit several beautiful offshore islands such as Poda Island, Chicken Island, Tab Island and Phra Nang Beach. Ample time will be allowed for swimming and sunbathing. Picnic lunch will be provided.
