This form is intended to outline the arrangement – determined and agreed to by the school counselor, student, and parent – for obtaining academic credit for course work taken abroad, in order for the student to meet graduation requirements. While abroad on his/her exchange program, the student will be enrolled in a local high school and will live with a host family. The educational benefits of an immersion study abroad program include language acquisition, cultural competency, and hands-on experience of world history, sociology, and geography, supplemented by classes taken at the host school.
